Monday-Friday | Oct. 4 – 8 | 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.

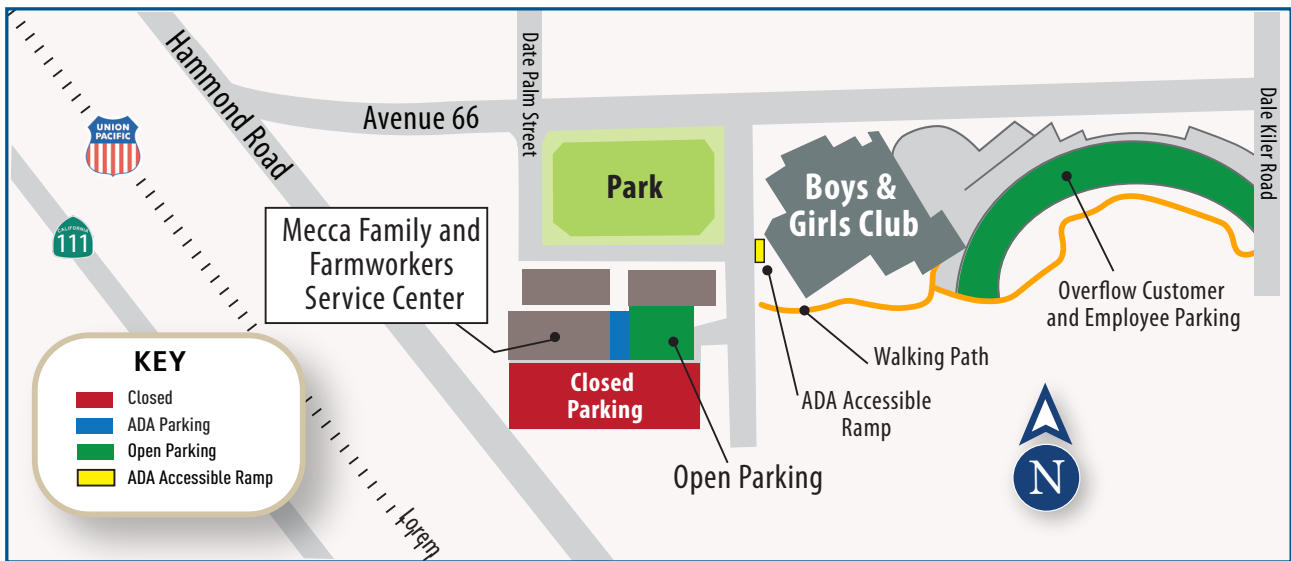
Crews continue removing the temporary wooden falsework from the new bridge and will require intermittent lane closures on Hammond Road with brief wait times for motorists. Flaggers will be onsite to safely assist motorists through the area.

Parking Lot Closure



A large part of the parking lot behind the Mecca Family & Farmworker’s Service Center, located at 91275 66th Avenue, will be closed beginning Wednesday, Oct. 6, for up to 6 weeks. The closure is necessary for crews to safely install a new underground sewer line that runs through the parking lot.

ADA accessible parking and limited customer parking will be available in front of the pharmacy and other businesses. Overflow parking is available in the Boys and Girls Club parking lot across the street. Please be extra cautious and aware of construction vehicles when walking to and from the shopping center.
